Adam - אדם

אדם

וייצר יהוה אלהים את־האדם עפר מן־האדמה  
ויפח באפיו נשמת חיים ויהי האדם לנפש חיה:

“And the LORD God formed man *of* the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. (Genesis 2:7 KJV)

## **Deeper Hebrew Meaning of the word Adam (אָדָם)**

A man, is a strong leader of the house. Protector of the family, who pitches his tent with Elohim, who goes through the door, who is Yeshua, and in so doing, receives the flowing stream the fountain of wisdom obtained through his relationship with Elohim.

Now, what if a man doesn't pitch his tent with Elohim, and doesn't go through the door, which is Yeshua? Well then, I would argue that he's not a very strong man, and he is not receiving the flowing wisdom that comes from going through that door.

## **Aleph**

Picture of an Ox, strong leader of the house. Protector

## **Dalet**

Picture of a door, or a tent. Pitching your tent with Elohim, Yeshua is the door. Also can represent the choice to open up our-selves.

## **Mem**

Picture of water. Can also mean to spring forth. Think of a flowing stream, or a fountain of wisdom.

Proverbs 18:4 – “The words of a man's mouth *are as* deep waters, *and* the wellspring of wisdom *as* a flowing brook.”

The very first word of that proverb is Mayim, which is the word for water.
